Overview

The Hawaii State Student Council is the voice of Hawaii's 180,000 public school students. The council meets on a regular basis to discuss student issues and youth concerns, and members also address issues before the state Legislature and Hawaii State Board of Education.

Secondary Student Conference

HSSC hosts two conferences annually. One focused on civic service and engagement called the "Secondary Student Conference". The conference brings student leaders across the state to engage in the legislative process.



Student Leadership Conference

HSSC hosts another conference focused on student leadership and development. The conference made 30 years in 2018. Student leaders from across the state engage in leadership workshops and training opportunities to prepare for the upcoming school year.



Structure

The Hawaii State Student Council, or better known as HSSC, consists of 42 members; they represent forty-one Hawaii public high schools and one Board of Education (BOE) student member. Each public high school is represented by one student to ensure that all the student voices of Hawaii are heard.

- *To schedule and hold regular open meetings for the discussion of student activities, student issues and concerns across the State of Hawaii*
- *To recommend courses of action to the Hawaii State Department of Education*

- *To facilitate communication among School Student Councils*
- *To uphold the ideals of servant leadership while constantly working towards the betterment of student education, life and welfare in Hawaii's public schools*
