Thank you for registering for the 29th annual Student Leadership Conference (SLC)! This year's SLC will be held at the University of Hawai'i at Mānoa from June 22 – June 24, 2017. Enclosed is some conference related information to help you prepare for SLC. All participants are asked to check in as a school on Thursday, June 22nd at the UH Mānoa Frear Hall dormitories from 11:00 AM – 1:00 PM.

Participants are requested to pack everything in one suitcase. A list of things to bring is printed below. Students should not bring any valuable items; the HSSC and UH Mānoa is not liable for any damaged or lost items. The registration fee is non-refundable and there will be no substitutions.

Registration and Dorming

Participants and chaperones will check-in, drop off their luggage, and register at Frear Hall before Lunch. All participants and chaperones will be housed at Frear Hall. Students will be assigned rooms according to their district and school. Participants are expected to be in their room by room check time and stay in their rooms thereafter. The dormitory will provide a pillow, a pillowcase, bed sheets, one bath towel, and one washcloth. However, it is suggested that participants bring their own bedding and towel.

Transportation

Neighbor Island

Airline Information: Check with your Student Activities Coordinator (SAC) on the status of your airline ticket. Please remember to bring your picture ID and be sure to have an identification tag on your luggage. It is recommended that you meet your chaperones one hour before flight time. **PLEASE BE ON TIME.** If you miss your flight, please return home. You may NOT take a later flight. All chaperones and participants will be allowed one free check-in bag. All chaperones and participants will be allowed one free check in bag for flights made by the state office or school.

Bus Transportation: There will be school buses to pick up the neighbor island participants from the airport. Busses are scheduled to leave between 9:30 a.m. and 11:30 a.m. Bus transportation will be provided for your return at the end of SLC. Student and adult participants from the neighbor islands must go to the bus parking area, ground level, directly Makai (ocean side) of the Hawaiian Airlines baggage claim area. Should there be any problem with flight delays on Thursday, June 22nd.

Oahu

Participants are required to find their own transportation on Thursday, June 22nd to UH Mānoa Frear Hall, to drop off your luggage. Check with your Student Activities Coordinator (SAC) to see if your district is offering bus transportation to and from UH Mānoa. **No parking will be provided.** Participants are required to arrange their own pick up on Saturday, June 24th.

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
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SUBJECT: **SLC 2017 Off-Campus Activity**
