Registration - A maximum of six (6) students may attend along with one (1) teacher chaperone. Schools will need to cover the cost of registration, lodging and travel. The registration fee is \$100 for student participants. There is no registration fee for teacher chaperones. Visit http://bit.ly/SLCHI2019 to register. The deadline is Friday, April 26, 2019.

<u>Transportation</u> - Roundtrip air and ground transportation to the conference site will not be provided. Schools must make their own arrangements and cover all costs. School bus transportation will only be provided to all participants between the HCC and Germaine's Luau.

<u>Lodging</u> - Overnight accommodations are not included in the registration fee however a group rate will be available to conference participants upon registration.

<u>Student Travel and Authorization Forms</u> - Schools must generate and retain their own forms, Parent/Legal Guardian Authorization for Student Participation and Travel (SA-1) and the Student Publication/Video Release Form.
