Transportation

Neighbor Island Participants

- Airline Information: Check with your Student Activities Coordinator (SAC) on the status of your airline ticket. Please remember to bring your picture ID and be sure to have an identification tag on your luggage. It is recommended that you meet with your chaperones one- two hours before flight time. **PLEASE BE ON TIME.** If you miss your flight please return home. You may NOT take a later flight.
- Bus Transportation - School bus pickup will be available only for those neighbor island schools that made arrangements with the state coordinator. Otherwise ground transportation is on your own. For Pagoda hotel guests, round trip bus transportation will be provided to and from Moanalua High.
- O'ahu Participants - Participants are required to find their own transportation on Friday, June 10, 2022 to Moanalua High School. Check with your Student Activities Coordinator (SAC) to see if your district is coordinating bus service. **Parking is available on site.** Participants are required to arrange their own pick up upon the closing of the conference.
