#### **SLC Overview**

Mahalo for registering for the 35th annual Student Leadership Conference (SLC)! This year's SLC will be held at the Hawaii Convention Center from June 8-10, 2023. Enclosed is some conference related information to help you prepare for SLC. All participants are asked to check in as a school on Thursday, June 8, 2023 at the Hawaii Convention Center starting from 9:00am. All participants will be dismissed from the Hawaii Convention Center on Saturday, June 10 at 3:00pm.

## **Neighbor Island Participants**

Airline Information: Check with your Student Activities
 Coordinator (SAC) on the status of your airline ticket. Please
 remember to bring your picture ID and be sure to have an
 identification tag on your luggage. It is recommended that you
 meet with your chaperones one-two hours before flight time.
 PLEASE BE ON TIME. If you miss your flight please return
 home. You may NOT take a later flight.



- Bus Transportation Will be provided only for those neighbor island schools that made arrangements with the state coordinator. Roundtrip transportation via a Robert's School Bus will go between the neighbor island terminal and the Hawaii Convention Center.
  - o For Maui District Pickup will be on Wednesday, June 7 at 11:00am
  - o For Kauai, Hilo and Kona Pickup will be on Thursday, June 8 at 8:30am
  - RETURN for all islands will leave the Convention Center at 3:00pm back to the airport.

#### O'ahu Participants

 Participants are required to find their own transportation on Thursday, June 8 to the Hawaii Convention Center. Check with your Student Activities Coordinator (SAC) to see if your district is coordinating bus service. Parking is available on site for a fee. Participants are required to arrange their own pick up upon the closing of the conference on Saturday, June 10.
